By registering the installation of an alarm system or the subsequent installation of such a system or by the continued use of an alarm system already installed at the effective date of this ordinance, the owner, lessee, or user thereof shall agree and does agree that such registration or use constitutes a waiver by such person of the right to bring or file any action, claim or complaint whatsoever against any law enforcement officer, firemen, or other authorized emergency service providers who, using their reasonable and best judgment, makes forced entry in response to such alarm into the premise on which such alarm is installed. If forced entry is required the emergency service provider will make a reasonable attempt to notify the owner or contact the police service to secure the property.
