AGRICULTURAL BUILDING: A structure utilized to store farm implements, hay, feed, grain, or other agricultural or horticultural products or to house poultry, livestock or other farm animals and a milk house. The term includes a carriage house owned and used by members of the recognized religious sect for the purposes of housing horses and storing buggies. The term shall not include habitable space or spaces in which agricultural products are processed, treated, or packaged and shall not be constructed to mean a place of occupancy by the general public.
