

Temporary Political Signs. (permit not required) Temporary political signs announcing political candidates seeking office, political parties, and/or political and public issues contained on a ballot shall be subject to the following:

- A. Permit – Permits for temporary political signs shall not be required.
- B. Location - On private property, temporary political signs may be located in any required yard.
- C. Height - Temporary political signs shall not project higher than 15 feet as determined in accord with the definition of *computation of height* in §27-1702.
- D. Timing - Signs may be displayed for a period not to exceed 30 days prior to the date of the election to which the signs are applicable and shall be removed within 7 days following the election.
- E. Road Setback - All political signs shall be located a minimum of 5 feet from the edge of the paving or curb line of any public or private road, and shall not create a traffic hazard.
- F. Support - Each political sign shall be erected on its own support and shall not be attached to any of the following: trees, utility poles, fences, guardrails, buildings or other structures.
