ORDINANCE NO. 49-B

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING LITTERING IN THE TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Jackson Township, Monroe County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. It shall be unlawful for any person within the boundaries of Jackson Township to throw any waste, papers, sweepings, ashes, household waste, commercial waste, glass, metal, refuse, or rubbish, or any dangerous or detrimental substance into or upon any public property or private property of another without the consent of the owner.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to interfere with, scatter, or disturb the contents of any public or private receptacle containing ashes, garbage, household waste, or rubbish without the consent of the owner.
3. Any person who shall violate any terms of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and upon conviction thereof, shall pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars for each said offense together with costs of cleaning up. In default of payment of said fines and costs, the violator shall be sentenced to imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days. All fines and costs recovered shall be paid to the District Justice.

4. Any employee of the Township shall be authorized to bring an action at the District Justice's office to enforce this Ordinance.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its adoption.
