Dear Scholarship Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. Scholarship Program. The men of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity support the continuing education of young African American males through mentoring and financial support. Students will be selected from a pool of applicants from the Philadelphia Public School system. Each award winner will receive, as a minimum, a \$1,000 scholarship from the Mu Omega Foundation of Delaware Valley, Inc. This scholarship will be awarded in June 2020. In addition, the \$1000 scholarship will again be granted for the scholar's sophomore, junior, and senior years, which will guarantee at least \$4000 total towards college expenses.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Must be a graduating male senior who will be matriculating to a four-year accredited college or university.
- Must have a solid high school academic record.

Students vying for the Mu Omega scholarship must demonstrate high academic standards or a gradual pattern of grade improvement throughout their high school career. In order to be considered for the scholarship, you, the student, must do the following:

- Complete an application
- Provide the committee with an official high school transcript
- Two letters of recommendation from someone other than a family member

The completed application must be sent to the address above, c/o Darryl Blackwell Mu Omega Scholarship Committee and postmarked no later than the April 24th, 2020. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
