Range Rules on Back

Hours of Operation:
Open Mon-Sun 10am to 6pm

Range Requirements:

- May not be a felon, under indictment, or pregnant to be permitted on the range
- Must be at least 18 to rent or handle firearms or
12 to 17 years old and accompanied by a documented legal guardian

Range Fees:

\$19.95 per hour per lane
\$9.95 for second person in same lane

Handgun Rentals:

Hourly – \$10 per Handgun, \$20 per Rifle
Special Pricing - ask in house

Memberships: \$369.00 One Year Unlimited, \$189.00 Six Month Unlimited

Classes:

Private Lesson \$60.00 First time users of handguns or experienced shooters are urged to further their firearm handling knowledge through lessons with our instructors. Mistakes or accidents while handling a handgun can be deadly. This is a one hour class offered on a first come first serve bases. Please call to make an appointment. Appointments may be made for Monday through Friday from 10am -3pm.

Ladies Night \$50.00 This is a two hour course consisting of classroom instruction and firing range. Ladies only. Fee includes all required equipment and materials including eye protection, ear protection, firearm rental, ammunition and targets. Collard shirts or high neckline suggested. No open toed shoes. Classes are held on Tuesdays from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Call for schedule of class.

Additional classes are being developed. Check the range "white board" or website for a current listing and availability.

Permitted Firearms:

Handguns ONLY, up to .44 magnum
.22 Caliber Rifles (exception)
Pistol Caliber Carbines
Handgun rental available
.50 Caliber Handguns are NOT permitted

Ammunition; for everyone's safety:

No greater than +P rated, no .50 caliber, no tracers (or other explosive or incendiary bullets), no armor piercing, no black powder

No handling of firearms except at the firing line.

If you need to do so, **FIRST** speak to the Rangemaster or Safety Officer.

For Your and Everyone's Safety Please Obey All Range Rules

Range Rules

- Upon entering Pocono Pistol Club please check in at the counter.
- Fill out all required paperwork prior to using range – if you have reserved a lane in advance, give yourself at least 15 minutes prior to the start of your shooting time to complete this check in process.
- You must complete the Release, Assumptions of Risks, and Indemnity Agreement each time you use the range.
- If it is your first time at Pocono Pistol Club you must take a brief safety and introductory course. (about 15 minutes)*
- Use permitted firearms and ammunition ONLY. (see other side)
- DO NOT handle guns unless you are at the firing line.
- Eye and ear protection must be worn inside firing line at all times.
- Always treat every gun as a loaded gun.
- Never point a gun at something you do not want to shoot.
- When renting a gun (minimum age 21), do not remove it from the case until you are in your lane at the firing line. When done, place back in case at firing line. Make sure gun is empty.
- When using the gun at the firing line, ALWAYS keep the muzzle pointed down range.
- If you have a problem with a gun at the firing line, place it down on the counter in your lane pointed down range, and come see a Rangemaster or staff in the retail area.
- Shoot in your lane at your target only! Violators will be asked to leave.
- Always know your background. Do not shoot above or below the bullet trap.
- Place one target at a time on the carrier.
- NO rapid firing.
- Clean up your brass after you are done, however, DO NOT cross the yellow line. You may either pickup and remove your brass, or use the squeegees to push it beyond the yellow line. (toward down range)
- Please remove all empty boxes and packaging from your booth and place it in the wastebasket.
- Upon completion of your range time please check out at the front counter.
- If your range time ends and you want to extend it, call the front desk by pressing the button on the intercom in your lane to see if additional time is available.
- Obey all directives from the Rangemaster or range staff.
- Review the Information Sheet for other rules and requirements.
