From the President



As we begin the New Year, the Chamber will be closely monitoring a select number of legislative bills in Harrisburg. One of these bills, the H.B515 a modest tax reduction bill, is designed to improve Pennsylvania's business climate. The provisions of this bill are to establish a single sales factor for the Corporate Net Income tax apportionment, raise the cap on net operating losses to \$10 million or 75 percent of a company's taxable income, and reduce the tax burden on small businesses and individuals by lowering the state's Personal Income Tax to 3.05 percent.

There will be upcoming debates concerning property tax reform for Pennsylvania from both sides of the aisle. We will follow the progress of these bills to ensure our members that any agreement our legislators reach on property tax reform will not place an undue tax burden on business, and that property tax relief is not limited solely to homeowners. There is a possibility that a comprehensive property tax reform package would place a referendum on the spring 2006 Primary Election ballot.

Other important legislative issues that the Chamber will follow are: repeal of the unfair legal doctrine of joint and several liability, increasing the minimum wage in Pennsylvania, and severance pay offset unemployment compensation benefits. Rest assured the Government Affairs Committee of the Chamber will examine any bills that will have an impact on our region or our members. We will do our best to act on your behalf for the greater good. The Pocono Mountains Chamber of Commerce is committed to the issues that affect its members and their businesses.
