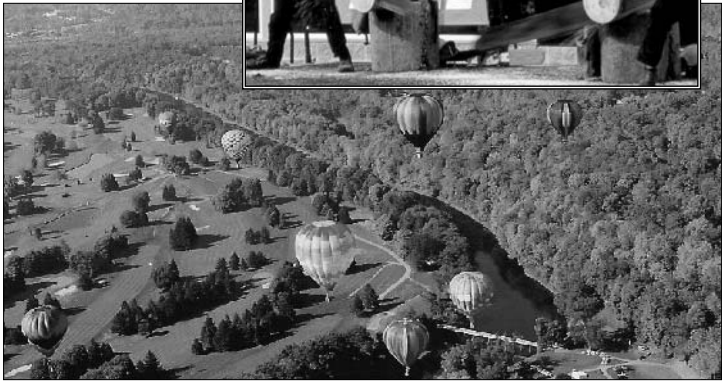

Developmental Education Services (DES), a local organization in the Pocono Mountains works with mentally handicapped adults in Monroe County to provide recycling and shredding services to the community. The organization works with these adults to pick up and recycle paper, cardboard, aluminum, and other recyclable materials. DES also has a state-of-the-art mobile shredding business where they take their own truck to a home or business that needs any type of confidential documents destroyed on the premises.
