Fact Sheet on Annual Talent Hunt Competition

1. **Purpose** – provides exposure, encouragement and financial assistance to talented youth.
2. **Eligibility** – all 9-12th grade Prince William County High School Students
3. **Categories** – students may compete in only one of the four following categories:
 1. Instrumental music – classical, popular or contemporary (6 minutes time limit)
 2. Vocal music - classical, popular or contemporary (6 minutes limit)
 3. Drama – dramatic interpretation (6 minutes limit)
 4. Dance – ballet, creative, modern or tap (6 minutes limit)
4. **Applications** – The student will submit the Talent Hunt Application and Parental Consent Form with a digital upload of their audition to the Pi Lambda Lambda Chapter Talent Hunt Committee to Dr. C. Victor Herbin, III or Mr. Ronnie Palmer at PLLTalentHunt@gmail.com by December 6, 2019. Application and Parental Consent form located at www.pllques.com/talent-hunt
5. **Competition** – All contestants need to provide a digital upload of their performance with their application to the Talent Hunt Program Committee. The committee will judge audition submissions and notify ten finalists by December 10, 2019. The Talent Hunt Committee will meet the top ten finalists and their parents to discuss the final details of the program, receive tickets, and details on souvenir book on December 14, 2019. The ten finalists will showcase their talent live on March 1, 2020 at Woodbridge High School in Woodbridge, Virginia and compete for the title as the Pi Lambda Lambda Talent Hunt Champion. The winner will then compete at the 87th Annual Third District Meeting April 16-20, 2020 at the Hilton McLean Virginia in McLean, VA.
6. **Judges** – At least 3 Judges will evaluate each student on the night of the competition representing experience in drama, voice, music, or dance.
7. **Recognition** – All finalists will be recognized with a scholarship prize at the conclusion of the Talent Hunt Program. Prizes for the competition include:
 - 1st Place - \$1000.00
 - 2nd Place - \$750.00
 - 3rd Place - \$500.00
 - 4th-10th Place - \$100.00
8. **Advertisement and Ticket Sales**- Each finalist will be distributed tickets and applications for ads to sell to family members, friends or businesses to show support and contribute to the scholarship prizes. Prizes for advertisement and ticket sales competition include:

• 1 st Place Ad Sales - \$200.00	1 st Place Ticket Sales - \$200.00
• 2 nd Place Ad Sales - \$150.00	2 nd Place Ticket Sales - \$150.00
• 3 rd Place Ad Sales - \$100.00	3 rd Place Ticket Sales - \$100.00
9. **Digital Upload**- The fraternity will not use the media for any purpose other than promotional advertisement and to pre-select the top ten finalists.
