- Be an African American male
- Be enrolled in a Prince William County, Stafford County, Manassas or Manassas Park School
- Be a graduating high school senior in the 2021 2022 school year
- Have a minimum high school cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Provide all required information on this form as a Microsoft Word or .pdf document
